## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH STORMONT

BY-LAW NO. 2020-025

<u>BEING</u> an Interim Control By-law to Prohibit the building

of new kennels or the expansion of existing kennels within the Township of South Stormont

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, c. 25 S. 5 (1) provides

that the powers of a municipal corporation are to

be exercised by its council;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, c. 25 S. 5 (3) provides

that the powers of every council are to be

exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS By-Law No. 2011-100 regulates the use of land

and the use and erection of buildings and structures within the Township of South

Stormont;

AND WHEREAS Section 38 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990,

permits the Council of a municipality to pass an Interim Control By-law where the Council has directed a review or study to be undertaken in respect of land use planning policies in the municipality or in any defined are or areas

thereof;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Township of South Stormont has

directed staff to undertake a review respecting land use planning policies pertaining to the building of any new kennels or the expansion of

any existing kennels within the Township;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Township of South Stormont is

authorized to pass an interim control by-law

through Section 38 of the Planning Act.

NOW THEREFORE Council of the Township of South Stormont

hereby enacts as follows:

1. That no person shall build any new kennels or

expand any existing kennels within the Township

of South Stormont.

2. The following are definitions for the purpose of

this by-law

a. Kennel shall mean a building or structure where dogs are kept, bred, boarded, groomed or trained, given medical treatment or housed for similar purposes for which compensation may be paid and shall include a Humane Society shelter or pound. This definition shall include any premise whereby four or more dogs are

kept as domestic pets.

- 3. That this by-law shall expire one year from the date of passing unless otherwise extended by By-law pursuant to Section 38 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13.
- 4. That this by-law shall become effective on the date of passing hereof, subject to the appeal provisions of the Planning Act.
- 5. That any by-law inconsistent with this by-law is hereby repealed.
