

Long Sault Arena – Facility User Rules – COVID-19

- All users must [self-assess](#) before their rental. It is the responsibility of the rental organizer to notify users to self-assess before their rental.
- The rental organizer must have a complete list of participants for their rental and provide to staff or EOHU if requested.
- Payment options available: An online payment option may become available this fall. Staff encourages online payments or cheque payments only. If a cash payment is required, please contact the Parks and Recreation staff to organize a time to make the cash payment during office hours (Monday to Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.)
- The Front Entrance is to be used to enter and exit the building; side doors are to be used as emergency exits only.
- Players and visitors must only arrive 20 minutes before their rental
- Players and visitors must exit the facility within 20 minutes after their rental, this will allow staff to properly sanitize the facility before the next rental.
- Maximum of 22 skaters on the ice per session. (This includes on-ice coaches and trainers)
- Players must not spit, blow their nose freely, or release any bodily fluid anywhere in the facility.
- Label water bottles - do not share.
- Masks are required. Face masks must be worn by all persons entering the facility and in dressing rooms. Players and on-ice coaches may remove their mask in the dressing room immediately before entering the ice area. Players and on-ice coaches masks are to be kept in a sealed container or bag in the dressing room while on the ice. Bench staff must wear masks.
- Facility will be open for rental users ONLY, unnecessary spectators will not be permitted.
 - If necessary, one parent/guardian per child will be allowed in the facility.
 - If necessary, for children 13 years and under, 1 parent/guardian may enter the change room to assist with equipment and must exit the change room when the player is dressed.
- Showers will not be available for use.
- Maximum of 8 participants per dressing room.
- Lobby maximum capacity: 25 people
- The canteen will be closed.
- Limited drinks will be available in the vending machines, food will not be permitted in the vending machines. Please prepare accordingly.

- All rules must be followed by all facility users. If rules are not followed, users will not be allowed to return to the facility.

 - Masks required unless seated and physically distanced.
 - Buffets will not be permitted - food must be served. Please follow guidelines from the Eastern Ontario Health Unit.
