# HIGHWAY 138 IMPROVEMENT AND SAFETY

After a recent Provincial announcement of over \$200 billion in roads and highways across the province, the Director of Parks and Recreation provided an update to Council that the municipality and its partners intend to advance advocacy for improvements to Highway 138.

This roadway has long been identified as a dangerous route for vehicular and pedestrian traffic, with a dire need for safety improvements such as passing lanes and intersection improvements.

## PLAN 279 PRELIMINARY AREA DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY

This preliminary long-term strategy received by Council supports a diverse range of housing options on Townshipowned lands in Ingleside.

The report aligns with the recommendations and directions of the recent Housing Needs Assessment conducted in 2024.

The preliminary strategy is designed to facilitate public engagement for the lands known as Plan 279 in Ingleside. As such, the preliminary strategy may change as more information is gathered.

Implementation of this strategy is a long-term goal. Watch for additional public engagement opportunities in the future.
