CAPITAL EQUIPMENT PURCHASES FOR LONG SAULT ARENA

After an unsuccessful grant application for arena equipment upgrades, the Director of Parks and Facilities requested Council amend the budgeted improvements to find cost efficiencies.

A new condenser and water treatment system was removed from scheduled work, while a dehumidifier was was added to the capital equipment purchases for 2025.

Township staff will continue grant application efforts for a new condenser and water treatment system to for future capital improvements to the arena.
