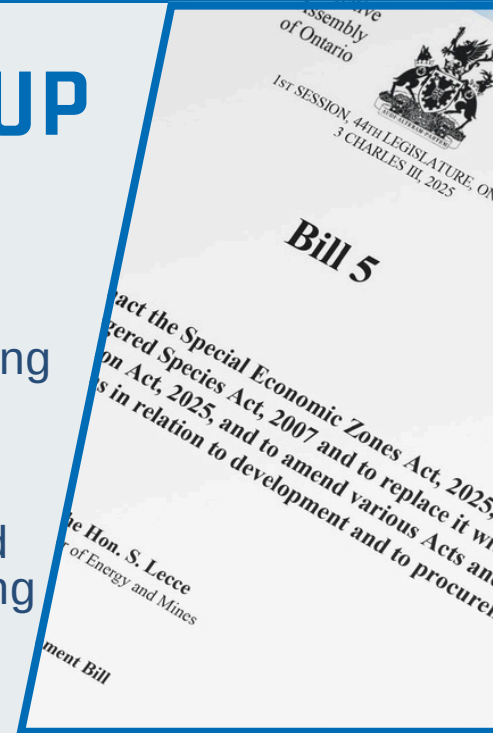




COUNCIL CATCH UP

LEGISLATIVE UPDATES: BILLS 5 AND 17

Bills 5 and 17 have received Royal Assent and introduce changes to development charges, planning applications, minor variances, heritage protections and environmental policies. Public comments on related regulatory changes are open until June 26, 2025. Township staff have submitted feedback and will continue monitoring the impact on local planning initiatives.



SPEED LIMIT BY-LAW UPDATES



The Director of Infrastructure Services provided a report to Council outlining an upcoming Speed By-law to consolidate all by-laws regulating traffic speed. Council directed staff to also make amendments to posted speed limits for built-up areas of the Township to 40 km/h.

The new Speed By-law is expected to be presented to Council for consideration at the June 25th Regular Council Meeting.

The Speed By-law is the first step towards developing safer roadways in South Stormont for pedestrians, cyclists, and vehicular traffic. Further improvements, including recommendations for traffic calming measures will be forthcoming.

>>> USE OF TOWNSHIP SYMBOLS

After recent concerns regarding Administration's interpretation of the Use of Corporate Logo Policy, Administration requested guidance from Council to define when the logo may be changed for the purpose of recognizing days of significance.



After Council discussion, the direction to Administration was to bring forward an amended Policy with more clarification for consideration in July.
