## 3 PARKS RECEIVING NEW PARK EQUIPMENT IN 2025

The Director of Parks and Recreation provided a report to Council about the awarding of a tender to purchase and install 3 new play structures in parks within South Stormont to Henderson Recreation Equipment Ltd.

The three parks scheduled to receive new equipment are Melanie Warner-Cain Memorial Park (Elm Street, Ingleside), Henry de Rooy Memorial Park (Lunenburg), and Mille Roches Park (Long Sault). While the tenders specified a final completion date no later than October 24, the hope is to have each park installed in September 2025.
