

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH STORMONT

BY-LAW NO. 2024-017

BEING a by-law to adopt a Radiocommunication / Telecommunication Facility Protocol.

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WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, c. 25, s. 5 (1) provides that the powers of a municipal corporation are to be exercised by its council;

AND WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, c. 25, s. 5 (3) provides that the powers of every council are to be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS the *Radiocommunications Act* R.S.O., 1985, c. R-2 enables the Minister to regulate and manage the siting of radiocommunication and broadcasting antenna systems in Canada;

AND WHEREAS Section 4.1 of the Radiocommunication and Broadcasting Antenna Systems CPC-2-0-03 Client Procedures Circular; a procedure manual developed by Industry Canada under the enabling legislation of the *Radiocommunications Act*, R.S.O., 1985, c. R-2 encourages a land-use authority to develop its own local processes;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it necessary to revoke the designation of the Canadian Radiocommunications Information and Notification Service as the representative for the submission of proposed radiocommunications sites for consultation and review within the Township's jurisdiction in accordance with Industry Canada's CPC 2-0-03, as amended;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it expedient and in the interest of the municipality to develop a local process for the siting of radiocommunication and broadcasting antenna systems within the corporate boundaries of the Township.

NOW THEREFORE Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Stormont enacts as follows:

1. That Council revokes the designation of the Canadian Radiocommunications Information and Notification Service as the representative for the submission of proposed radiocommunications sites for consultation and review within the Township's jurisdiction in accordance with Industry Canada's CPC 2-0-03, as amended.
2. That the Radiocommunication / Telecommunication Facility Protocol, attached hereto as Schedule "A" and forming part of this by-law, be adopted.

3. That the Director of Planning and Building be authorized to make minor revisions to the protocol, as required from time to time.
4. That this By-law shall come into full force and effect on the date of passing.
5. That any other by-law inconsistent with this by-law is hereby repealed.
