During winter 2025/2026, no changes have been made to the maintained sidewalks within the Township.

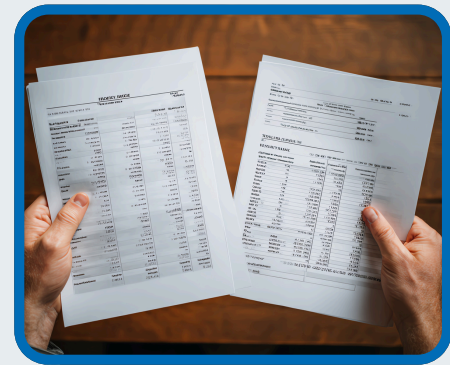

A Public Meeting was held to provide information regarding an application for a Zoning By-law Amendment for a property at 17463 Headline Road.

The amendment proposes a change to allow for an “agricultural use, small” and a riding arena for a limited number of horses on the lands.

TOWNSHIP CELEBRATES COMPLETION OF 3 NEW PLAYGROUNDS THANKS TO \$168,800 GRANT FROM ONTARIO GOVERNMENT

Members of Council and staff were joined by MPP Nolan Quinn and members of the Ontario Trillium Foundation (OTF) Grant Review Team to celebrate the completion of three new accessible playground structures in South Stormont.

The Township received \$168,800 to install new equipment at Mille Roches Park (Long Sault), Melanie Warner-Cain Park (Ingleside) and Henry De Rooy Park (Lunenburg).
